

Assalamu Alaikum

We are now starting the process of registration for Inspiring Grace Scouts. The Scouts Club will be launching on Saturday 2nd March 2019 and the deadline for registering your child is Sunday 17th February 2019.

Places will primarily be allocated to parents who attended the Open Day, and then to everyone else on a first-come, first-served basis. Please be aware that there is an overwhelming interest in scouting and we anticipate that we will be launching with a waiting list – as are many other Muslim scout groups around the country. Therefore we need everyone receiving this message to action it as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

Please note, Inspiring Grace Scouts will **only** run during **school term times**.

The Beavers (6 – 8 year olds) section will meet on a Sunday from 10:30am – 12pm at the Railway St. Community Centre.

The Cubs (8 - 10.5 year olds) section will meet on a Sunday from 12:30pm – 2pm at the Railway St. Community Centre (**VENUE, DAY & TIME SUBJECT TO CHANGE** – details will be shared accordingly)

Times may change between Saturday and Sunday Morning/Afternoon time during the year.

To be sure of a place for your child we request that the following requirements are met:

- Payment of £50 registration fee
- Set up a standing order of £12 a month per child

Furthermore before the launch of the club all beavers and cubs will be required to purchase an official uniform. More details will follow on where to purchase uniforms.

The programme outline for the first year, for both Beavers and Cubs will be as follows – but may be subject to change:

- Membership Award (Badge) – introduction to Scouting, and investiture (Scout Promise, etc.)
- My Adventure Challenge Award (Badge) – includes activities such as building a den, climbing, archery, cooking on an open fire, nature walks, obstacle courses and much more
- My Outdoors Challenge Award (Badge) – includes how to set up a tent, collecting wood, building a fire, learning how to tie knots, First Aid, learning about and identifying different animals, helping animals and more.
- Activity Badges such as Gardener Activity Badge, Animal Friend Badge (for those with pets), Space Activity Badge (Astronomy) & Faith Badge.

We are currently oversubscribed and need all parents who are receiving this message to action as soon as possible, otherwise the reserved place will have to go to another child. Thank you for your cooperation.
